### OAAS Quilt Competition

To be eligible for the OAAS Quilt Competition, quilts in Sections 1 & 4 must be a minimum of 72" x 90". **Grand Champion Hand Quilted Quilt & Grand Champion Machine-Quilted Quilt** are eligible to be entered at the District 13 Annual Meeting Competition in November 2017. The winners of the District competition will be entered in the Ontario Competition at the OAAS Convention in February 2018 in Toronto. Both jars submitted **MUST** be from the same batch.

All jars **MUST** have new rings and seals. Any jars submitted with rust will be disqualified.

Preserves must be entered in the Curling Club Monday, August 7th, from 5 pm - 8 pm, or Tuesday August 8<sup>th</sup>, from 10 am - 3 pm. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**

Opened jars may be picked up Thursday, August 10, from 9 am - 2 pm.

All display jars must remain until after 5:00 p.m., Sunday, August 13th.



**NOTE: If your fruits and vegetables are not ready at fair time, you may submit 2 jars from the same batch of your 2016 preserves. Jars MUST have a label stating they are a 2016 preserve.**
