RULES:

Arts, Crafts & Photography entries may be delivered to the Old Curling Club **Tuesday August 1, 2017 to Thursday August 3, 2017 from 11am to 2pm and 3pm to 5pm.**

Baking entries are to be delivered **Tuesday August 8th from 9am – noon.**

Parents please encourage but allow the children to do the work themselves.

Please DO NOT put address or phone number on **entry tags**, but be sure to include them on your **entry form.**

Please attach entry tags on **Art, Craft & Photography** entries **on the front**, in the top right corner.

Baking entry tags are to be attached to the front middle of plate, or outside front of bag or plastic when covered.

Limit of 1 entry per child per section. Entries **MUST be new this year!** CORRECT AGE AS OF AUGUST 1, 2017.

Your “grade” means “during the 2016/17 school year.”

No late entries in any section will be permitted!

Judging will begin Tuesday Aug 8th at 1:00pm. **PLEASE – NO SPECTATORS.**

All prizes to be picked up **Friday August 11th from 2pm to 4pm in the Curling Club where entries are displayed.** Entries may be picked up **Sunday August 13th from 6pm – 8pm.** **PLEASE NOTE: ALL entries, ribbons, and/or prizes not picked up by 3:00 pm on Wednesday August 16/2017 will be forfeited.**

Entry tags and forms are available at the Fair Board Office, beginning mid July, and on entry days. (you may also use photo copies) **Each child must have their own form. Junior Fair is separate from Junior Flowers or Agriculture and MUST have its own entry form submitted.**

“Baking With Honey”

3 cookies, using the following recipe on a small covered plate, and an empty Clovermead Bees & Honey container MUST accompany your entry.

RECIPE: HONEY COOKIES

1 1/3 cups oil	1 tsp. Salt
2 cups sugar	2 tsp. vanilla
2 eggs	4 cups flour
1 cup Clovermead honey	Sparkly sugar for rolling
4 tsp. Baking soda	

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. In mixing bowl, stir together oil, sugar, eggs, honey, soda, salt and vanilla. Mix well. Stir in flour, stirring just until it is mixed in. Shape into 1 inch balls, roll in the sparkly sugar. Place 2 ½ inches apart on ungreased or parchment lined cookie sheet. Bake for 10 – 12 min. Should be nicely browned around the edges, crackly, and golden when done. Makes 7 dozen.

“Easy Apple Rolls”

Ingredients:

10 slices white bread	1/3 cup melted butter / margarine
1/2 cup sugar	1 teaspoon cinnamon (or a bit more is ok)
1 can apple pie filling or homemade filling	

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 / 180 degrees.
2. Cut the crusts off your bread and roll each slice flat with a rolling pin. Combine cinnamon and sugar in a small dish.
3. Pour the apple pie filling onto a plate and chop it so the pieces are smaller.
4. Put about 1 tablespoons (or how much fits without squeezing out ends) apple pie filling on each slice of bread and roll up. (can leave space to lightly squeeze open ends together to keep filling in)
5. Dip each piece into melted butter so they are lightly coated, then roll in the cinnamon sugar mix.
6. Place seam side down on a parchment lined pan and bake 15 minutes or until browned and slightly firm.
